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### Centre Manager's Message


Happy New Year and welcome to 2025.

The last three months have been very busy in the Centre as we completed our first full year of operating. Some highlights in the latter part of 2024 and early 2025 include:

- confirmation from the Federal Government
  Department of Education that funding for our CUC
  Mallee has been secured for the next 4 years!
- 144 student registered for Semester 2 2024. October was our busiest month with 310 student visits.
